This is a non-shooting class.

You may want to bring snacks or lunch and drinks with you, although please be advised that there is no food or drink allowed in the range. There will be a 45 minute lunch period so you would have time to go out for a quick lunch. Dressing in layers and bringing a seat cushion are both good ideas!
